

IQ INTEGRATED – USER’S GUIDE

SOFTWARE INFORMATION

IQ Integrated is a quiz and maze based game, with the aim of testing the player’s analytical skills. For all question related levels, there is a 15 second time limit. Once you finish the game, your analytical skills will have improved*, and you will work better under time constraints*.

IQ Integrated is separated into 2 sections – quiz levels and maze levels, which are evenly distributed in the game. To help you, we’ve added power-ups – Extra Life, Skip Question and Add More Time. If you want a description of them, you shouldn’t be playing this game. Just kidding, play the game.

INSTALLATION


We’ve made it simple to run the program. A shortcut to the program is provided within the *IQ Integrated* folder. Double-click it, and the program is open. Simple. If it isn’t simple, you shouldn’t be playing this game. Only joking (again), play it. It’ll be good for you.

All files required are generated on first launch, so it may take longer to open. It’ll be quicker next time.

There are no installation requirements that need to be mentioned. This program works on every Windows PC. It won’t work if you’re on a Mac or a Linux PC, unless you’ve got Windows in a virtual machine. It won’t run if you’ve got 1MB of RAM and a CPU running at 1Hz. If you’ve gotten this far, then don’t worry about hard disk space. It’s on your computer now, so you must have enough space. Modern computers have a 1080p display (1920x1080), so it will work. Any lower, then it will... work. Got you there, amirite?


QUIZ LEVEL

Here, you read the question shown at the top of the screen. Then you click on an answer. Most of the time, it is 1 of the 3 answers shown. We’re not kidding. The answer might be somewhere else around the screen.



MAZE LEVEL

You must navigate your cursor from where you started to the finishing box. But be warned, there are jumpscare if you touch a wall... Only pulling your leg, the cursor will move back to the start. Trust? Okay, good. The finishing box isn't where you think it might be, so use your logical thinking skills¹!

TROUBLESHOOTING
